HOW TO PROJECT YOUR SCREEN/DEVICE (E.G., PHONE, COMPUTER)

TO THE TV MONITOR IN THE COMMONS - ROOM 3233 ETMSW

For Apple MacBook users

Before you proceed, ensure that

- Your MacBook is manufactured in year 2012 or later.
- You are running OS X version 10.9 ("Mavericks") or later. If not, you will have to update your operating system.

How to project your screen to the TV

- 1. Connect your MacBook to the wireless network "Commons-TV." No password is required.
- 2. Using the TV remote control and pointing towards the TV, press the "Input" button until "HDMI 3" is highlighted.
- 3. Press the circle button on the middle of the remote control.
- 4. Look for the AirPlay Status icon on the top of the bar, to the left of time display , as shown as the example below:
- 5. If no icon is shown, restart your computer.





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For Apple MacBook users - continued

- 6. Click on the AirPlay status icon and choose "Apple TV." The "mirroring" option will also appear.
- 7. Slide the button so it turns green.
- 8. Your MacBook is now synchronized its display to the TV.
- 9. To turn off the display, redo step 4 but slide the "mirror" green button to turn it off.
