



HOW TO PROJECT YOUR SCREEN/DEVICE (E.G., PHONE, COMPUTER)
TO THE TV MONITOR IN THE COMMONS - ROOM 3233 ETMSW

For Apple iPad, iPod, & iPhone users (AirPlay Mirroring)

Check if your device meets the hardware requirements:

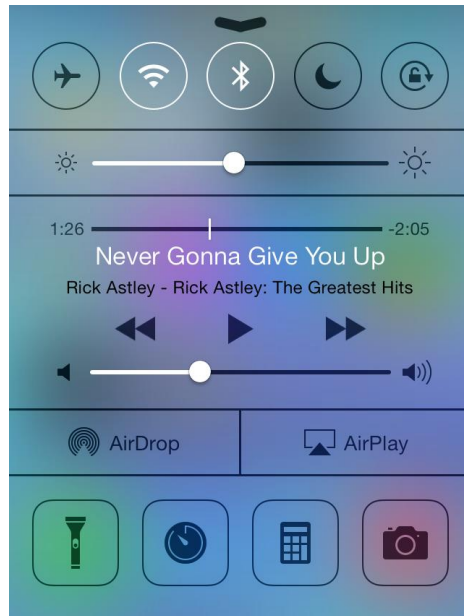
- iPhone 4s or later
- iPad 2 or later
- iPod touch (5th generation or later)

If you do not have the correct hardware, you won't be able to connect to the TV.

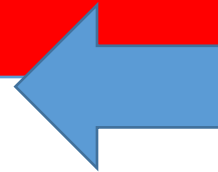
Generally, any of the above hardware that is produced after year 2012 will be able to connect to the TV.

How to project your screen to the TV

1. Connect your iPhone or iPad to the wireless network "Commons-TV." No password is required.
2. Using the TV remote control and pointing toward the TV, press the "Input" button until "HDMI 3" is highlighted.
3. Press the circle button on the middle of the remote control.
4. On your iPhone or iPad, once you connected to the Commons-TV network, go back to the main screen.
5. Now, swipe up from the bottom of the screen to access the Control Center.

6. Click on the "AirPlay" button.
7. A menu will be shown.
8. Choose "Apple TV".
9. The Mirroring button will also be shown.
10. Slide the button so it turns green.
11. Your device should be now synchronized with the TV screen.
12. To disconnect, repeat step 4-6 and slide the mirroring button to turn off.
