

HOW TO PROJECT YOUR SCREEN/DEVICE (E.G., PHONE, COMPUTER)
TO THE TV MONITOR IN THE COMMONS - ROOM 3233 ETMSW

For Windows laptop users

How to project your screen to the TV

1. Connect your laptop to the wireless network “Commons-TV.” No password is required.
2. Using the TV remote control and pointing toward the TV, press the “Input” button until “HDMI 1” is highlighted.
3. Press the circle button on the middle of the remote control.



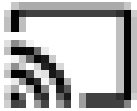
4. On your computer, launch Google Chrome browser. If you do not have Google Chrome, download it at <http://chrome.google.com/>
5. On Google Chrome, download the latest Google Cast extension.

For Windows lap top users - continued

6. Once installed, in the top right corner of your Chrome browser, you should see the Cast button that looks like this:



7. On the list of cast devices, choose "Commons TV."
8. Click on the arrow on the upper right corner, and choose "Cast Full Screen".
9. You are now projecting your laptop screen to the TV.

Note that doing ANY of the following will disconnect your screen from the TV:

- Closing the Google Chrome browser
- Disconnecting from the "Commons-TV" wireless network.
- Moving a couple of doors beyond The Commons, Room 3233.
